ELIGIBILITY:

All Indigenous students who are children/grandchildren (including foster children/grandchildren) of a current or retired member of a Component or affiliate of the National Union of Public and General Employees and are planning to enter the 1st year of a Canadian public, post-secondary education institution in 2020/2021 are eligible to apply.

AWARD:

The amount of the scholarship is \$2,500.
