# SCHOLARSHIP FOR LGBTQI2S STUDENTS

## CRITERIA:

Winner will be determined on the basis of a 750 to 1,000 word essay on:

*The importance of trade unions in supporting the LGBTQI2S community.*

An application form must be completed and accompany the essay.

Marks are allocated for presentation.

## ELIGIBILITY:

All LGBTQI2S students who are children/grandchildren (including foster children/grandchildren) of a current or retired member of a Component or affiliate of the National Union of Public and General Employees and are planning to enter the 1<sup>st</sup> year of a Canadian public, post-secondary education institution in 2020/2021 are eligible to apply.

## AWARD:

The amount of the scholarship is \$2,500.
