

## Shuttle Service

Shuttle buses are being run by Winnipeg River Charters. Buses should have the NUPGE logo to help identify them

### Thursday June 20 - registration day

- 5:30 pm - starting at the 2 main hotels (Fairmont and Fort Garry), loop through the hotels adding in the Radisson and the RBC Convention Centre.
- final departure from the Convention Centre will be at approx. 9:30 pm.

### Friday June 21

- 7:45 am - starting at the 2 main hotels (Fairmont and Fort Garry), loop through the hotels adding in the Radisson and the RBC Convention Centre so that all attendees arrive by 8:50 at the convention centre ready for the 9:00 start.
- 5:00 pm – buses loop back to hotels from convention centre – at 5:45 will start looping to the Manitoba Museum until 11 pm.
- \* Anyone attending the unveiling of the Permanent Monument to the Winnipeg General Strike should return to the Manitoba Museum for the shuttles

### Saturday June 22

- 6:45 am - starting at the 2 main hotels (Fairmont and Fort Garry), loop through the hotels adding in the Radisson and the RBC Convention Centre so that all attendees arrive by 8:50 at the convention centre ready for the 9:00 start.  
\* Shuttles start early so that participants can attend the Women's Caucus
- 5:00 pm – buses loop back to hotels from convention centre – at 5:30 will start looping to the Canadian Museum of Human Rights (CMHR) for the tours and banquet until 6:40 pm.
- 10:00 pm - 1:00-1:30 am - loops from the CMHR back to the hotels
