# National Union of Public and General Employees' Advisory Committee on Young Workers' Issues (ACYWI)

#### Mandate / Terms of Reference

#### Article 1 - Mandate

The NUPGE Advisory Committee on Young Workers' Issues (ACYWI) will:

- a) Identify and make recommendations for action to the National Executive Board on specific problems and concerns confronting young workers (in their union, at work, at home, and in community lives).
- b) Work with NUPGE Components to further their work on issues for young workers.
- c) Cooperate and work with organizations that address issues of concern for young workers.
- d) Develop strategies to encourage young worker's participation at all levels with a view to strengthen the labour movement.
- e) Strengthen solidarity by helping to remove the barriers faced by young workers in all parts of the world.

## Article 2 - Membership

The ACYWI will consist of young workers from NUPGE Components who:

- a) Are under the age of 35 and;
- b) Are in good standing with their union and Component union.

Each NUPGE Component is entitled to send 1 representative to join the ACYWI.

### **Article 3 - Meetings**

ACYWI meetings will:

- a) Occur twice a year through either conference call, video conferencing, or face-toface meetings – subject to change by the National Executive Board.
- b) Be chaired by a NUPGE staff member.
- c) Be supported by NUPGE staff who will be responsible for meeting logistics and topical research.
